Instructions

To use either Setup Guide, first position it, suitably aligned, on the floor at the intended listening position. If you have a hard floor then the guide can be fixed directly to it using adhesive tape; if you have a carpet or rug then first attach the template to a flat sheet of hardboard, wood or even metal, and then place this in the desired position (being careful not to move it during the setup process).

The lines on the template can then be used to position the speakers in the system one at a time. This is most easily achieved using a laser line but can also be undertaken using a long straightedge. Once the angular alignment of the speaker is correct, a tape measure should be used to ensure that its distance from the listening position is also correct.

If the surround speakers are to be wall-mounted, mark the correct position on the skirting board and then use a spirit level or laser line to carry that position up to the required height. Note that the angular position of the two surround speakers should be the same on both sides.
